SOPHOMORE PRIORITY

"Sophomore priority" (Class of 2019 & 2020) noted in the schedule means students are allowed to register for the course in the following order: sophomores, first year students, seniors, juniors. A senior or junior wanting to register for such a course must waitlist in the "WL" section and may register for the course if the instructor grants permission, however, waitlisted sophomores and first year students will have waitlist priority. The Registrar's Office sends emails to waitlisted students who have permission to register; students will have one day after receipt of this email to register for the course online.

INDEPENDENT STUDY

Independent study registration is a paper process. You will not be able to register for independent study via the web. You must submit your completed independent study forms to the Registrar's Office by the published deadline during normal business hours. 290/390, 291/391, 292/392 for all subjects, as well as BIOL 394, CHEM 394 and PHYS/ASTR 356 PSYC 300, are considered independent study and require a paper registration process. Forms for BIOL 394, CHEM 394, PHYS/ASTR 356 and PSYC 300 are available on the HUB or from the Registrar's Office; and independent study forms are also available in the respective academic departmental offices.
